The Tulalip Tribal Court is a general civil and misdemeanor criminal court. The Judicial Clerk will draft orders, research motions, draft memorandum on discreet legal issues, participate in multi-disciplinary meetings for drafting of rules. The position may require confidential research on procedural or substantive Indian criminal justice issues.

2L or 3L preferred, but 1L may be considered depending on experience. Preferred applicants have excellent writing and interpersonal skills. You must have your own vehicle and laptop.

Pay is \$15.15 per hour Part-time (15 hrs/week) positions are available during Full and Spring semesters. Full or part-time positions are available during Summer.

This position requires travel to and from the Court. Mileage is reimbursed
